

NTUE Alumni Education Fund Donation Incentive Guidelines

Amended and approved at the 156th Administrative Meeting on October 31, 2018

1. In order to encourage alumni to actively donate to National Taipei University of Education (hereinafter referred to as the university) "NTUE Alumni Education Fund" and to achieve the effect of accumulating small amounts to make a large impact, these guidelines are established.
2. All donations are to be made by the donor to the "National Taipei University of Education Endowment Fund 401 Account," specifying the purpose as "NTUE Alumni Education Fund" on checks or remittance forms.
3. Donors who contribute an annual amount equal to or exceeding NT\$100,000 will receive a certificate of appreciation or plaque from the university. They will also be invited to receive recognition at the annual university anniversary ceremony.
4. Alumni who contribute an annual amount equal to or exceeding NT\$10,000 or accumulate donations of NT\$10,000 or more within the year will receive a certificate of appreciation from the university. The names of these donors will be published in the university magazine.
5. Donors contributing a single or cumulative amount equal to or exceeding NT\$500,000 within the year may be eligible for additional acknowledgment according to the university's "National Taipei University of Education Acknowledgment for Donations Policy."
6. When the NTUE Alumni Education Fund reaches the goal of NT\$12 million, following the example of the centennial celebration's bell tower fundraising, the names of donors contributing over NT\$10,000 will be engraved at a suitable location on campus for permanent commemoration.
7. Upon reaching the NT\$12 million goal for the NTUE Alumni Education Fund, a "Hōran-kai Pusher Commemorative Special Issue" will be published. Donors will be thanked in the following ways:

(a) Donors contributing a total amount equal to or exceeding NT\$100,000 will have their names, photos, academic and career achievements, and outstanding contributions featured in the special issue, with at least one page dedicated to each donor.

(b) Donors contributing a total amount between NT\$10,000 and NT\$100,000 will have their names, photos, and brief resumes featured in the special issue, with each donor allocated a quarter page.

(c) Donors contributing less than NT\$10,000 will have their names and donation amounts listed in the special issue according to a specified format.

8. The funds raised through this donation are dedicated for specific use. They should adhere to the university's regulations on full scholarships for outstanding freshmen and financial aid for underprivileged students. The funds must not be used for other purposes. The list of award and aid recipients and the disbursement details for the year should be submitted to the Alumni Association by the end of January of the following year.

9. After approval by the Administrative Meeting, these guidelines are submitted to the president for final confirmation and implementation.
